HOW TO USE THIS MANUAL

Welcome to Mission Opportunities for Nurses! The purpose of this manual is to help you find a good fit for you and your nursing skills.

One of the best ways to use this manual is to start with the table format section. The first column of the table is divided into areas of the world (eg. Africa, Asia etc.) Under each area, there are health facilities that want nurses to come and work for them. Some health facilities desire short-term and others long-term commitments.

Go horizontally along the top row of each table and find your specialty. See what health facilities are in need of your specialty. After finding the places that desire your skill, go through the manual and find that facility. Each facility gives an overview of their work, the opportunities that are available, length of stay, cost, and who to contact.

The last table of the section provides a list of sending agencies. These agencies send nurses to multiple countries each year. Most of the trips are short-term visits from one week onwards. If you are interested in going with one of these agencies, you can write to them and get their calendar of trips for the year.

We are praying that you will find just the right place to use your nursing skills to serve Him.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN SELECTING A MISSION ORGANIZATION

FOCUS	If you feel a call to a specific place find an organization that works there.
STRATEGY	Choose an agency that has the type of ministry focus you are called to do.
MAKEUP	Select an agency with your specialty.
THEOLOGY	Know your beliefs and match these with the agency you are considering.
EXPERIENCE	Is the agency experienced in what it is doing?
SUPPORT	Is the agency supported by the denomination or is it faith-based in which they train their missionaries in fund raising?
SUCCESS	Is the agency growing or shrinking?
MANAGEMENT	Centralized or decentralized. Decentralized gives more control to the field.
CULTURE	Some foster close relationships while some find it difficult due to size, geography or other factors.
OPENNESS	Will the mission let you go and experience their work through short-term missions? Will they answer your questions?

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: I am not a nurse or a doctor, can I still volunteer for a medical mission?

A: Yes! Many medical organizations have needs that non-clinical people can help with, so if you feel a calling to a particular mission, give them a call to discuss. Some mission organizations ask volunteers to complete a personal information and/or skills checklist to help match your skills and interests to specific project assignments. *Remember that God is looking for those who are available and ready to serve.*

Q: What's the difference between the information in the M3 conference materials *Nursing Resource Manual* and the *Mission Hospital* handouts?

A: The Nursing Resource Manual is very **specific** for nurses and *includes what specific nursing training and degree* a hospital or organization prefer. The Mission Hospital resource is a list of organizations who have expressed they will often receive both medical and non medical volunteers. Nurses *only* need the Nursing Resource Manual.

Q: How do I get started?!

A: Spend time in prayer, asking God for direction on selecting and serving in a mission. Call the mission organization that you are considering and ask questions. Ask to speak with persons who have served in the mission recently, to get information about recent experiences.

Q: What are the costs associated with a medical mission?

A: Costs are different for each mission opportunity, but generally include costs associated with air/ground travel, housing, food and water.

Q: How will I pay for my medical mission trip?

A: Volunteers typically pay for their trip themselves or fundraising from friends and family. The mission organization will let you know if any scholarships exist to help volunteers cover the costs of the trip. The costs associated with the trip are generally paid in advance.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (CONT'D)

Q: Will I be safe while I am on this mission trip?

A: While there are inherent risks associated with traveling abroad for mission projects, mission organizations have safety and security processes in place to protect volunteers. It's important to be informed of these processes and follow them.

Q: How long do volunteers serve?

A: Project length is different for each mission, some projects can be as short as one to two weeks, while some projects may require that volunteers serve for one month.

Centro Evangelico de Medicina Health and Hope through Christ

Lubango, Angola

OVERVIEW

Originally funded by USAID and Samaritan's Purse, the CEML is a non-profit, mission hospital serving a catchment population of over 3 million in southern Angola. CEML's medical service not only covers the gamut of primary and tropical disease healthcare, but also performs advanced general and orthopedic surgery. Missionary staff include: two surgeons, an internist/oncologist, two obstetrician/gynecologists (one part time), a half-time ophthalmologist, and one nurse.

OPPORTUNITIES

Visiting nurses are given the opportunity to present teaching sessions in their area of expertise. Nurses will have the opportunity to observe much primary and tropical pathology in the main hospital facility as well as remote healthcare posts in the interior of Angola.

Egbe Hospital Revitalization Project

Egbe, Nigeria

OVERVIEW

Egbe Hospital and School of Nursing were started in the 1950s by SIM missionaries Dr. George & Esther Campion. They serve a rural population in south-west Nigeria of about 300,000. In 2011 the Egbe Hospital Revitalization project was established by Don Campion, son of the original founders and the work done to date has been most remarkable! The School of Nursing is currently being upgraded to a College of Nursing, so Nurse Educators are needed at this time – both long and short term.

OPPORTUNITIES

Registered nurse practitioner, operating room nurse, emergency room nurse, intensive care nurse, nurse anesthetist, pediatric nurse, and optical/ophthalmologist nurses are needed to support the nursing staff in the delivery of best practices and provide practical clinical teaching. Qualified Nurse Educators are needed to teach in the ECWA School of Nursing to teach and disciple nurses to serve throughout Nigeria. The volunteer will participate in the health service delivery in a very rural and under-served area of Africa. Primitive living conditions surround the town of Egbe where people survive on basic farming, fishing, and trading. Learning how to make the most out of limited resources will be an eye-opener for western volunteers. Knowing that you have made a difference through mentoring, training, and working alongside these wonderful people will be a life changing experience.

OVERVIEW

Mbingo is part of the Cameroon Baptist Convention Health System of 6 hospitals and about 20 health centers.

The Mbingo Hospital is a referral hospital in Cameroon and the West Africa Sub Region. The Hospital is an approved HIV/AIDS treatment center. It provides comprehensive healthcare.

OPPORTUNITIES

The hospital is emphasizing training hospital nursing staff in specialty areas. These areas are ICU, neonatology, wound and ostomy care, and anesthesia.
